Dear Brothers and Sisters,

After much planning, discussion, and feedback from you, our parish family, we are ready to embark on our Transforming Lives: Advancing God's Vision Capital Campaign! While the Campaign will result in expanding and renovating our current Parish Center space, it really serves as a means by which we live out the vision God has placed for this parish to transform lives in Jesus Christ. Over the years, as our parish family and community have grown, we have been very intentional in what we do as missionary disciples and how we use our resources. Whether it is creating space to welcome and engage people before, during, and after Mass, providing rooms for children's ministry and other ministry meetings and events during the week, or ensuring the space meets the needs of those in our community to join us as we help them form a relationship with Jesus, we need to ensure our current and future needs are met.

Our Parish Center was built in 1988. While it provided good use for many years, we can see that the large room dividers lack sound dampening and are in disrepair, technology is lacking throughout, the restrooms are outdated and inadequate in size, mechanical and

electrical systems need major updating, and safety and security systems need to be brought to current standards. Many of our parishioners can testify to the lack of updated meeting space. In a feasibility study conducted for the Capital Campaign, the vast majority of the parishioners who responded were in favor of moving ahead with a campaign.

The Parish Center addition will add much needed office space for staff, as most of the current office space will be repurposed as part of the Parish Center renovation. Also, the addition will add needed meeting rooms of various sizes, new restrooms, and custodial and storage rooms. To keep costs manageable, the Parish Center renovation and addition will be the priority projects. Our current plan is to address the parking lot improvement and other renovations that are needed as a later phase of the Campaign.

This brochure provides more information with respect to the necessary plans to ensure that we raise the funds needed to live out our parish vision and continue to grow God's kingdom here at St. Patrick Parish. Whether you are new to St. Patrick or have been here for many years, I ask that you prayerfully consider how you have been blessed by this Parish and how you may to able to contribute financially to make this vision a reality. My hope and prayer is for everyone to participate according to their means so that we may all collectively take part in this new phase of our parish home.

Sacrificial giving is an expression of our faith and a way to put our faith into action. Time will be set aside during all Masses on the weekend of April 27th and 28th for the faithful of St. Patrick Parish to make a pledge. On that weekend, please complete and bring your enclosed pledge card to Mass, or be prepared to complete a pledge card at Mass. Campaign Case >>>

Now, over thirty-five years old, we are at a point where our Parish Center needs major renovation and expansion to address the space needs of our growing parish community. The space is not adequate for the needs we have now and expect to have in the future. Both the Church and the Parish Center serve as a means by which we live out our vision. Funds raised from the Capital Campaign will provide needed space for Family Faith Formation, evangelization, fellowship, ministry, and staffing.



Project Scope Parish Center Addition

Add approximately 7,000 square feet of space along the West side of the current Parish Center, to include:

- Four meeting rooms of various sizes
- New staff offices
- New restrooms
- Storage rooms

Parish Center Renovation

All current single and shared offices will be repurposed for new uses, including hospitality space near the narthex, a dedicated space for children during Mass, and renovated meeting/multipurpose rooms. Also included in the parish center renovation plans are:


- New sound dampening room dividers and other finishing updates for the main parish center space
- Installation of secure entrances to the parish center
- Updated and enhanced technology in meeting spaces and hospitality areas
- Updated kitchen and restrooms
- Updated mechanical and electrical systems

*These renderings depict the exterior of the addition as currently planned, which is to be constructed on the west side of the current Parish Center, and a sample of meeting rooms included in the Parish Center addition.

Renderings have not been finalized and are subject to change.

St. Patrick's newly formed Building Team, comprised of parishioners in construction and related fields, is currently reviewing our proposed drawings to optimize design plans and cost saving opportunities.

Estimated Cost as Presented: \$4 - \$4.5 Million


