

Liturgical Ministry Volunteer Application

The requirements for Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion at Mass, Ministers of Care, and of Lectors includes:

- a) Fully initiated in the Catholic Faith (Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation or have been received into Full Communion with the Catholic Church)
- b) they must be 16 years of age or older (21 + for Ministry of Care) and registered at St. Patrick Parish
- c) if married, they must have had a valid marriage in the Roman Catholic Church.
- d) you will need to produce a new certificate of baptism which includes the dates for your 1st Communion, Confirmation, and (if applicable) Marriage. If you have made a Profession of Faith in the Church, please provide that certificate. The certificate must be **dated within the last 6 months**. If you received all your sacraments at St. Patrick, just let us know that and we can look it up. If you need help to locate your Baptismal certificate, contact Catherine Sims.
