### (1) Capital Campaign Donations and Restricted Revenue

**Net Operating Surplus (Deficit)** 

The FY2026 budgeted revenue for the Capital Campaign was projected using data based on existing donor commitments, it does not include anticipated new commitments or informal donations expected in 2026. Therefore, actual revenue may exceed the budgeted amount.

### (2) Employee Retention Credit (ERC)

Investment in Faith Formation Program

Investment in St. Mary School

The FY2025 actuals include ERC funds received for prior year payroll periods. These credits will not reoccur in FY2026 and were excluded from the budget.

#### (3) Professional and Outside Services

The FY2026 budget includes approximately \$250,000 in projected expenses related to the Capital Campaign building project, contributing to the overall increase in this category.

### (4) Faith Formation Program Investment

The increase in FY2026 reflects a strategic investment in parish faith formation initiatives. However, the overall increase in expenses is primarily due to staffing changes, including the budgeting of salaries for previously unfilled positions.




